

## **Booking FAQ:**

- How do I add minutes to an inmate's phone account?  
Phone services for the Lawrence County Detention Center are contracted through City Telecoin Inc. Contact information is 1-800-682-0707 or go to <http://www.citytelecoin.com>. The Lawrence County Detention Center has also placed a kiosk in the Sheriff's Department lobby so that calling cards can be placed into an inmate's commissary account. The kiosk accepts cash and credit cards. Calling cards can be bought in increments of \$10.

- How can I find out if I have a warrant for my arrest?  
The Lawrence County Detention Center cannot provide this information to you. If you need to know if you have a warrant for your arrest you will have to come to the Sheriff's Department with a photo ID and speak with an officer.
- How can I help an inmate get a job inside the jail?  
Once an inmate is sentenced they are added to a job list. As jobs become available they are given to the inmates that are currently on the list. Families should not call the jail requesting for their loved ones to receive a job. We have a strict policy that we follow for this.
- How do I find out an inmate's outdate?  
The Assistant Jail Administrator calculates all time for the inmate's in the Lawrence County Detention Center. If the inmate is a TDOC inmate, the state is responsible for calculating their time. If you have any questions about an inmate's outdate, you can call booking and they will help you.
